

BJP state executive meet on poll plan tomorrow

CHANDIGARH, JULY 6

The state executive of the BJP will meet in Faridabad on Sunday to prepare a strategy for the next year's Lok Sabha and Assembly elections.

A day before, senior BJP leaders, district presidents, district in-charges and state office-bearers will meet in Faridabad.

BJP Haryana affairs in charge Anil Jain and Chief Minister Manohar Lal Khattar will preside over the July 8 meeting.

Party sources say the meeting would prepare a plan for publicising flagship schemes of the Central and state governments. "The aim is to create awareness among the masses about several pro-people programmes of the Central and state governments to reap electoral gains in parliamentary and Assembly elections," they said.

The BJP is convening the meeting at a time when the INLD-BSP alliance and the Congress are getting on the offensive against several acts

Suicide by varsity don: Teachers want VC to go

A section of teachers are demanding the removal of the Vice-Chancellor (VC) of the Sirsa-based Chaudhary Devi Lal University, Dr Vijay Kayat, following the incident of suicide by Dr Praveen Agamkar, a Professor and Controller of Examination on Wednesday.

Videos have went viral showing certain teachers and non-teaching staff of the university shouting at Dr Kayat in his office and manhandling his PA Hori Lal.

In another video, the deceased professor's brother is seen shouting at the VC.

Even as Dr Kayat is seen standing with folded hands before the victim's brother to pay his condolences, Prof Agamkar's brother is seen angrily telling him that an officer is not supposed to torture his subordinates.

Fifteen university teachers have submitted a mass resignation letter to the university Chancellor, Governor Kaptan Singh Solanki, requesting him to relinquish them from their additional charge. In their resignation let-

ter, the teachers have questioned Dr Kayat's ways of functioning.

The teachers alleged that the VC's "autocratic" style of functioning was responsible for stress that forced Prof Agamkar to end his life and they, too, were unable to withstand that stress.

Teachers are demanding Dr Kayat's removal and an independent probe into Prof Agamkar's suicide.

Meanwhile, Dr Kayat has lodged a formal complaint with the district authorities as well as the district police against some teachers, non-teaching employees and research scholars for entering his office, manhandling him and thrashing his PA Hori Lal.

"Nearly five to six teachers, two-three non-teaching staff members and some research scholars barged into my office on Wednesday, shouted at me, manhandled me and thrashed my PA. I have sought legal action against them," the VC told *The Tribune*.

Dr Kayat said Prof Agamkar's suicide was a very unfortunate incident and

everyone in the university was in a state of shock.

Prof Agamkar was among the best teachers of the university and I enjoyed very cordial relations with him, he said.

Denying any torture or giving stress to the victim, Dr Kayat maintained that after he joined duties, he appointed a deputy controller of examination Amit Sangwan to assist Prof Agamkar.

"Since his family members wanted to take the body to his native place in Chhatisgarh for cremation, the university has arranged an ambulance for his body and the transportation of the family," the VC said.

Meanwhile, in her statement to the police, Prof Agamkar's widow has said that he was under stress of work.

The police said proceedings under Section 174 of the CrPC for unnatural death had been carried out and report of the victim's viscera was awaited.

Prof Agamkar had committed suicide on Wednesday by hanging from a grill at his residence. His wife, daughter and a maid were at home at that time.

Rapped, state submits details of cases against Asaram's son

Just about a month after the police landed in the dock for supplying incorrect information on the number of matters registered against self-styled godman Asaram's son Narayan Sai, the government has told the Punjab and Haryana High Court that only four cases were pending against him.

Panipat DSP Rajesh Kumar furnished his unconditional and unqualified apology for any inadvertent mistake or inconvenience to the court. Narayan Sai was seeking bail in an attempt-to-murder case registered at Panipat some three years back.

As the petition filed by Narayan Sai through advocates RS Cheema and AS Cheema came up for resumed hearing in the High Court on the previous date of hearing, Justice Daya Chaudhary directed the state counsel to file a specific affidavit for explaining "as to why wrong information has been supplied". He was also asked to



specify why the affidavit filed in the High Court was not in consonance with the direction already issued by the Bench on May 18.

Justice Chaudhary, on that date, had asked the state counsel to file a specific affidavit on the number of cases registered against the petitioner. The state counsel was asked to specify the status of cases.

The direction came after RS Cheema, in response to a court query, submitted that three cases were pending against the petitioner, including the present one. The state counsel, on the other hand, referred to an affidavit dated March 1, 2017. Filed by DSP Headquarters, Panipat, Jagdeep Singh, it stated that nine cases were pending against the petitioner and his father.
